Recent Developments

Global News

- <u>COVID-19-related deaths</u> <u>dropped nearly 90%</u> globally this week compared to the steep toll recorded in February, the <u>World Health Organization</u> (WHO) announced <u>Wednesday</u>.
- A <u>panel of outside advisers</u> to the **U.S.** FDA on <u>Wednesday voted against authorizing</u>
 Veru Inc's drug for treating high-risk patients hospitalized with COVID-19, citing
 multiple concerns over efficacy and safety data being based on a small trial.

Regional News

- China on <u>Friday eased some of its COVID-19 curbs</u>, including <u>shortening by two days</u> <u>quarantine</u> times for <u>close contacts</u> of cases and for <u>inbound travellers</u> and <u>scrapping a penalty on airlines</u> that bring in infected passengers.
- Hong Kong's government said on Monday it was relaxing COVID-19 restrictions on inbound tour groups including allowing them to enter theme parks and museums after arriving in the financial hub.
- With coronavirus <u>cases quickly rebounding</u> throughout **Japan**, the country's <u>eighth</u> <u>pandemic wave</u> may <u>match or exceed the previous wave's peak</u> of more than 260,000 daily cases seen in August, the health ministry's experts panel said <u>Wednesday</u>.
- Korea is in its <u>seventh wave</u> of the Covid-19 pandemic, the government declared <u>Wednesday</u>, and is <u>maintaining the indoor mask</u> mandate and the <u>7-day quarantine for confirmed patients</u>.


- <u>Beijing</u> residents can start <u>making appointments</u> for an <u>inhalable COVID booster</u> made by CanSino Biologics, media reported on <u>Thursday</u>, while those in <u>Tianjin</u> city can now get it as the **Chinese** pharmaceutical firm distributes more supplies.
- Approval has been granted on <u>Wednesday</u> in the **UK** for a Pfizer/BioNTech <u>bivalent</u>
 <u>Covid vaccine</u> that targets both the <u>original strain</u> of SARS-CoV-2 and the Omicron
 <u>BA.4 and BA.5 sub-variants</u>.

ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)






World: New Cases by Region

ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population


(7-day average; thousand cases)
