Recent Developments

Global News

- The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (<u>CDC</u>) said on <u>Monday</u> it had <u>ended its COVID-19 country travel health notices</u> as fewer countries reported enough data for accurate assessments.
- WHO data released late on <u>Wednesday</u> showed that <u>cases</u> in the **European Union** reached 1.5 million last week, <u>up eight percent</u> from the prior week. Hospitalization numbers across many countries in the 27-nation bloc have gone up in recent weeks.

Regional News

- **China**'s Covid-19 cases <u>climbed to the highest in about a month</u>, driven by people <u>traveling</u> during the week-long <u>National Day holiday</u> and sparking <u>a fresh round of</u> <u>restrictions</u> aimed at preventing the spread of the virus to other parts of the country.
- **Hong Kong** will make Covid <u>PCR tests available within walking distance</u> for about <u>five</u> <u>million people</u>, and <u>slash prices</u>, the government said in a statement on <u>Thursday</u>.
- Hong Kong increases the cap on restaurant dining from eight to 12 per table and raises the limit on groups in gyms, yoga studios, and karaoke lounges from October 6.
- Nearly 1 in 2 South Koreans have been infected with COVID-19, with the reinfection rate on the rise, the government said Wednesday.

Vaccine News


- Japan's health ministry on <u>Wednesday</u> approved Pfizer's coronavirus vaccine targeting the original strain to <u>children aged between 6 months and 4 years old and</u> <u>Pfizer's updated coronavirus vaccine</u> tailored to <u>protect against</u> the <u>BA.5</u> subvariant.
- Indonesia is in <u>talks with several African</u> countries, including Nigeria, to <u>export and</u> <u>donate its homemade COVID-19 vaccine</u>, its developer said on <u>Friday</u>.










ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population (7-day average; thousand cases)
