Recent Developments

Global News

- The **United States** on Thursday extended the COVID-19 pandemic's status as a public health emergency for another 90 days, keeping policies including high hospital reimbursement rates and expanded Medicaid.
- Another wave of COVID-19 infections may have begun in **Europe** as cases begin to tick up across the region, the World Health Organization and European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control said on Wednesday.

Regional News

- **China** has no timetable for easing the Zero-Covid policy yet, head of a National Health Commission expert panel Liang Wannian made the remarks in an interview with state broadcaster CCTV on Wednesday.
- **Hong Kong** will allow live performances and dancing to take place indoors from next Thursday as the city's government considers increasing the limit on the number of people allowed to gather in public, the under-secretary for health said on Thursday.
- Fifteen out of 100 people who caught COVID-19 have been reinfected in **Singapore**, and another wave could be around the corner if this number climbs, Health Minister said on Monday.

Vaccine News

- **Korea** begins to use Moderna's bivalent COVID-19 vaccines as a booster for the first time from Tuesday, the Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency said Monday.
- **Hong Kong** said on Wednesday it had approved a version of the BioNTech Covid-19 vaccine for babies and children under five years old, part of broader measures to boost vaccination uptake.
- **Indonesia** officially launched the country's first domestically produced COVID-19 shot on Thursday, marking an important milestone on the country's road to vaccine independence.




ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)






World: New Cases by Region
