#### **Recent Developments**

#### **Global News**

- The **United States** on <u>Thursday extended the COVID-19 pandemic's status</u> as a <u>public health emergency</u> for another 90 days, <u>keeping</u> policies including <u>high hospital</u> reimbursement rates and expanded Medicaid.
- Another wave of COVID-19 infections may have begun in Europe as cases begin to tick up across the region, the World Health Organization and European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control said on Wednesday.

#### **Regional News**

- China has no timetable for easing the Zero-Covid policy yet, head of a National Health Commission expert panel Liang Wannian made the remarks in an interview with state broadcaster CCTV on Wednesday.
- **Hong Kong** will <u>allow live performances and dancing</u> to take place <u>indoors from next Thursday</u> as the city's government considers <u>increasing the limit</u> on the number of people <u>allowed to gather in public</u>, the under-secretary for health said on Thursday.
- <u>Fifteen out of 100 people</u> who caught COVID-19 have been <u>reinfected</u> in **Singapore**, and <u>another wave</u> could be around the corner <u>if this number climbs</u>, Health Minister said on Monday.

#### **Vaccine News**


- **Korea** begins to use Moderna's <u>bivalent COVID-19 vaccines</u> as a booster for the first time <u>from Tuesday</u>, the Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency said Monday.
- Hong Kong said on Wednesday it had <u>approved</u> a version of the BioNTech Covid-19 <u>vaccine for babies and children under five years old</u>, part of broader measures to boost vaccination uptake.
- Indonesia <u>officially launched</u> the country's <u>first domestically produced</u> COVID-19 shot on Thursday, marking an important milestone on the country's road to <u>vaccine</u> independence.

# ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)






### World: New Cases by Region

## ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population


(7-day average; thousand cases)

## Selected ASEAN+3: COVID-19 Hospitalizations


(Thousand persons)
