Recent Developments

Global News

- The European Medicines Agency has warned that a <u>new wave</u> of COVID-19 is expected to hit **Europe** <u>within a week</u>. It added that the virus is <u>evolving faster than the</u> <u>ability to supply adaptive vaccines</u>, which are still in the early stages of development.
- Qatar is to <u>drop pre-arrival COVID-19 tests</u> before the World Cup, the health ministry said on Wednesday, weeks after announcing that the <u>incoming fans do not need</u> <u>vaccinations</u>.

Regional News

- Across China, 28 cities have implemented <u>varying degrees of lockdown measures</u>. This comes after China on Thursday reported a <u>third straight day</u> of <u>more than 1,000</u> <u>new COVID-19 cases nationwide</u>.
- The **Philippines** will soon <u>drop</u> the <u>COVID-19 test requirements</u> for <u>incoming visitors</u> and the <u>mask-wearing mandate</u> for <u>indoor settings</u>.
- Hong Kong announced that <u>public barbecue sites</u> will <u>reopen</u> and <u>operating hours for</u> <u>restaurants and clubs would be extended</u> from November 3. Additionally, individuals will be <u>allowed to remove their masks</u> during <u>group photos</u> at events such as weddings.

Vaccine News

- In China, Shanghai has started administering an <u>inhalable COVID-19 vaccine</u> on Wednesday in what appears to be a <u>world first</u>. The vaccine, a mist that is sucked in through the mouth, is being <u>offered for free</u> as a <u>booster dose</u> for previously vaccinated individuals.
- **Singapore** has granted <u>interim authorisation</u> for <u>Pfizer's Comirnaty bivalent COVID-19</u> booster vaccine.
- AstraZeneca's COVID-19 vaccine has been linked to a <u>30 percent higher risk</u> of getting a <u>rare blood clotting condition</u> compared to the Pfizer jab, a large international study said on Thursday.













