## Recent Developments

### Global News

- The **World Health Organisation (WHO)** has warned that the possibility of the emergence of deadlier and more infectious coronavirus variants remains and urged all to continue to practice caution during the weekly media briefing on Wednesday.
- **Australia** on Wednesday announced mandatory Covid-19 isolation would be cut from seven to five days for people without symptoms and mask requirements lifted on domestic flights from September 9.

### Regional News

- Several of **China's** biggest cities including Chengdu, Guangzhou, Harbin, and Shenzhen, have stepped up COVID-19 restrictions this week, curtailing the activities of tens of millions of people.
- **Hong Kong's** Chief Executive announced Thursday that he had secured preliminary backing from mainland Chinese authorities for a "reverse quarantine" scheme allowing travellers to undergo isolation in the city first before heading across the border.
- Prime Minister said Wednesday that **Japan** will allow the entry of non-escorted visitors on package tours and raise the daily arrival cap to 50,000 starting September 7.
- **Korea** will lift its current pre-departure COVID-19 test requirement for inbound travellers starting September 3, Second Vice Health Minister said Wednesday.

### Vaccine News

- **Canada** authorized Moderna's bivalent COVID-19 shots on Thursday, in the country's first approval of a vaccine targeting both the original virus and the Omicron variant.
- **The European Medicines Agency (EMA)** on Thursday backed the use of Novavax's COVID-19 shot as a booster for adults, ahead of an anticipated rise in infections this winter.
- The **U.S.** Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on Thursday recommended the use of redesigned COVID-19 booster shots for people aged 12 years and older to target the BA.4 and BA.5 Omicron subvariants of the coronavirus.




## ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)



### World: New Cases by Region




### ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population
