Recent Developments

Global News

- The **World Health Organization (WHO)** announced on Thursday (Aug 25) that <u>a million people had died</u> from COVID-19 <u>in 2022</u>, calling it a "tragic milestone" when all the tools existed to prevent deaths.
- Almost <u>40 percent of hospitalization</u> in the **United States** during <u>BA.2</u> were vaccinated and boosted, according to the findings from the US Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), highlighting Omicron's mutations impaired vaccine effectiveness.

Regional News

- China will <u>allow foreign students to return to China</u> after more than two years of Covid-19-induced border restrictions. From <u>Wednesday</u>, overseas nationals with valid residence permits for study can enter the country.
- Hong Kong will tighten some anti-pandemic measures, including imposing a compulsory quarantine on elderly close contacts of Covid-19 patients and extending mandatory tests to groups of more than eight people dining together at restaurants.
- **Japan** will <u>no longer require</u> incoming travelers to show a <u>pre-departure negative</u> <u>COVID-19 test result</u> starting on <u>September 7</u>, provided they have been <u>vaccinated</u> three times, Prime Minister said Wednesday.
- **Singapore** will <u>do away with requirements to wear masks indoors</u> starting <u>August 29</u>, as the country sees its COVID-19 situation stabilize further, the health minister said on Wednesday.

Vaccine News


- The Health Sciences Authority (HSA) in Singapore has <u>extended the authorization</u> of <u>Moderna</u>'s Spikevax Covid-19 vaccine - via the Pandemic Special Access Route - to children, including those between 6 months and 5 years old.
- <u>Nuvaxovid</u>, the COVID-19 vaccine developed by Novavax, has today been <u>granted an extension</u> to its existing **UK** <u>approval</u>, for <u>12- to 17-year-olds</u>. This extension has been authorized by the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA).

ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)






World: New Cases by Region

ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population


(7-day average; thousand cases)

Selected ASEAN+3: COVID-19 Hospitalizations


(Thousand persons)
