Recent Developments

Global News

- The World Health Organization (WHO) Director-General notified at a press briefing on <u>Wednesday</u> that the <u>reported coronavirus deaths</u> over the <u>past month</u> have surged <u>35%</u> and noted there had been <u>15,000 deaths in the past week</u>.
- The U.S. is <u>set to begin shifting costs</u> of COVID-19 vaccines and treatments to the <u>commercial market</u>, ending the practice of the U.S. government purchasing the drugs and making them available at no cost.
- The chief of the U.S. CDC on Wednesday <u>acknowledged</u> that the agency had <u>failed to</u> <u>respond effectively</u> to the COVID-19 pandemic and said it will prioritize its public health response in a revamp of its structure.

Regional News

- **China** reported its <u>worst week of Covid-19 infections</u> since mid-May, fuelled by outbreaks in vacation hotspots (Hainan, Tibet, and Xinjiang) that <u>risk spreading</u> across the country as <u>travellers return</u>.
- Japan confirmed 255,534 <u>new COVID-19 cases</u> Thursday, <u>hitting a daily record</u>, as the nation struggles with the seventh wave of infections. A total of 287 deaths were reported, and a health ministry advisory panel warned the toll may <u>continue to grow</u>.
- South Korea on <u>Wednesday</u> reported 180,803 new Covid-19 infections, <u>the highest</u> <u>figure in four months</u>. The new cases <u>fell below 140,000 Friday</u>, but <u>daily deaths</u> reached a <u>three-month high</u> amid the Omicron subvariant wave.

Vaccine News

- The World Health Organization (**WHO**) on <u>Thursday recommended the use</u> of French drugmaker <u>Valneva's COVID-19 vaccine</u>. It also recommended the use of <u>a second</u> <u>booster dose</u> for some individuals <u>at high risk of severe disease</u>.
- The **U.S.** White House Covid coordinator said on <u>Wednesday</u> that the <u>newly updated</u> <u>Covid boosters</u>, which <u>target the omicron subvariants BA.4 and BA.5</u>, as well as the original strain of the virus, will be <u>available</u> and <u>everyone over 12</u> will be <u>eligible</u> for it.





ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)








