Recent Developments

Global News

- Nearly **1 in 5 U.S.** adults who reported having COVID-19 in the past are still having symptoms of long COVID, according to survey data collected in the first two weeks of June from the National Center for Health Statistics.
- **France** is facing a new wave of Covid-19 infections fuelled by new variants of the disease, said French vaccination chief on Wednesday.
- **South Africa** has repealed COVID-19 rules that made masks mandatory in indoor public spaces, limited the size of gatherings, and imposed entry requirements at its borders, the health minister said on Thursday.

Regional News

- **Hong Kong's** incoming leader John Lee said he is working on a strategy to reopen Hong Kong's borders with mainland China and the rest of the world, including a possible reduction of mandatory quarantine for travelers.
- **Thailand** has lifted its mask mandate and allowed bars and pubs to remain open for longer hours as the COVID-19 situation in the country improved, according to an announcement signed by Prime Minister and published on Thursday.
- It is unlikely that **Singapore** will tighten Covid-19 rules across the board in response to the recent upswing in virus cases, public health experts said. Singapore has seen an uptick in cases driven by the BA.4 and BA.5 Omicron subvariants.

Vaccine News

- An estimated 19.8 million deaths were averted in the first year after COVID-19 vaccines were introduced, according to a study published in The Lancet Infectious Diseases on Jun 23.
- **The Philippine** government has rolled out the first Covid-19 booster shots to immunocompromised children aged 12 to 17 in hospitals on Wednesday.




ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)




ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population
