Recent Developments

Global News

- Nearly <u>1 in 5</u> U.S. adults who reported having COVID-19 in the past are <u>still having</u> symptoms of long COVID, according to survey data collected in the first two weeks of June from the National Center for Health Statistics.
- **France** is facing a <u>new wave of Covid-19</u> infections fuelled by new variants of the disease, said French vaccination chief on <u>Wednesday</u>.
- South Africa has <u>repealed COVID-19 rules</u> that made masks mandatory in indoor public spaces, limited the size of gatherings, and imposed entry requirements at its borders, the health minister said on <u>Thursday</u>.

Regional News

- **Hong Kong**'s incoming leader John Lee said he is working on a strategy to <u>reopen</u> <u>Hong Kong's borders</u> with mainland China and the rest of the world, including a possible <u>reduction of mandatory quarantine</u> for travelers.
- **Thailand** has <u>lifted its mask mandate</u> and allowed <u>bars and pubs</u> to remain <u>open for</u> <u>longer hours</u> as the COVID-19 situation in the country improved, according to an announcement signed by Prime Minister and published on Thursday.
- It is <u>unlikely</u> that **Singapore** will <u>tighten Covid-19 rules</u> across the board in response to the recent <u>upswing in virus cases</u>, public health experts said. Singapore has seen an uptick in cases driven by the BA.4 and BA.5 Omicron subvariants.

Vaccine News

- An <u>estimated 19.8 million deaths were averted</u> in the first year after COVID-19 <u>vaccines were introduced</u>, according to a study published in The Lancet Infectious Diseases on Jun 23.
- **The Philippine** government has rolled out the <u>first Covid-19 booster</u> shots to <u>immunocompromised children aged 12 to 17</u> in hospitals on Wednesday.





ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)







ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population (7-day average; thousand cases)




