## Recent Developments

### Global News

- The new variants, **BA.4** and **BA.5**, are expected to become the dominant strain and will likely be associated with an increase in infections in the coming weeks, according to the NSW Health respiratory surveillance report issued Jun 16 in **Australia**.
- People flying within **Canada** or departing on international flights will no longer have to show proof of vaccination to board an airplane or train. The changes will go into effect on June 20 but can be rescinded should COVID-19 case numbers increase over time.

### Regional News

- A bar-linked COVID-19 outbreak in Beijing China is easing after the testing of millions of people and the halting of some leisure businesses, the city said Thursday.
- **Hong Kong's** chief executive Carrie Lam on Friday urged residents to avoid banquets and other large gatherings amid a resurgence in the cases which has exceeded 1000 for the past three consecutive days.
- **Thailand's** Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) announced Friday that the Thailand Pass for everyone visiting the country has been scrapped. The move is set to come into effect from 1 July.
- **Indonesia** has recently reported 5 locally transmitted cases of the **BA.4** and **BA.5** sub-lineages of the Omicron Covid-19 variant in the highly populous Jakarta, Health Minister told the press on Monday.

### Vaccine News

- Advisers to the US Food and Drug Administration on Tuesday unanimously recommended that the agency authorize Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine for children and teens aged 6 to 17 years of age.
- The World Trade Organization (WTO) ministers approved a package of agreements that included the partial patent waiver for Covid-19 vaccines Friday.




## ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)



### World: New Cases by Region




### ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population
