Recent Developments

Global News

- The new variants, <u>BA.4 and BA.5</u>, are expected to <u>become the dominant strain</u> and will likely be associated with an <u>increase in infections</u> in the coming weeks, according to the NSW Health respiratory surveillance report issued Jun 16 in **Australia**.
- People flying within Canada or departing on international flights will <u>no longer have to</u> <u>show proof of vaccination</u> to board an airplane or train. The changes will go into effect on <u>June 20</u> but can be rescinded should COVID-19 case numbers increase over time.

Regional News

- A <u>bar-linked COVID-19 outbreak in Beijing</u> **China** is <u>easing</u> after the testing of millions of people and the halting of some leisure businesses, the city said <u>Thursday</u>.
- **Hong Kong's** chief executive Carrie Lam on Friday urged residents to <u>avoid banquets</u> <u>and other large gatherings</u> amid a <u>resurgence in the cases</u> which has exceeded 1000 for the past three consecutive days.
- Thailand's Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) announced Friday that the <u>Thailand Pass for everyone</u> visiting the country <u>has been scrapped</u>. The move is set to come into effect from <u>1 July</u>.
- Indonesia has recently reported <u>5 locally transmitted cases of the BA.4 and BA.5</u> sublineages of the Omicron Covid-19 variant in the highly populous <u>Jakarta</u>, Health Minister told the press on Monday.

Vaccine News

- Advisers to the US Food and Drug Administration on Tuesday unanimously recommended that the agency authorize Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine for children and teens aged 6 to 17 years of age.
- The World Trade Organization (WTO) ministers <u>approved a package of agreements</u> that included the partial <u>patent waiver for Covid-19 vaccines</u> Friday.





ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status (Percent of population)








