#### **Recent Developments**

#### **Global News**

- About <u>75 percent of children</u> and <u>58 percent of all Americans had been infected</u> by Covid-19 by the end of February this year, according to a new study on antibodies by the **U.S.** Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) released on Tuesday.
- The European Union Health Commissioner Stella Kyriakides said Wednesday that between 60 percent and 80 percent of the EU population was estimated to have been infected with COVID-19.

#### **Regional News**

- As many as 12.4 million Shanghai residents, <u>4.5 million more than a week ago</u> in China's financial hub, are now in <u>lower-risk areas</u>, meaning they can leave their homes, the government said on Friday.
- **Korea** said on Friday it will <u>lift an outdoor face mask mandate next week</u> in the country's latest step to ease Covid-19 restrictions, despite opposition from the incoming government which labelled the decision "premature".
- **Malaysia** announced that it will broadly <u>lift COVID-19 restrictions beginning May 1</u>, including the removal of a <u>mask mandate while outdoors</u> as well as dropping the need for fully vaccinated travellers to be tested for the coronavirus.
- **Thailand** Pass scheme will <u>not be scrapped</u> as widely anticipated, but the <u>registration</u> <u>process</u> for overseas tourists <u>will be shortened</u> as the Test and Go scheme is scheduled to end on April 30, the CCSA assistant spokesperson said Thursday.

#### **Vaccine News**


- **U.S.** biotech firm Moderna said Thursday it had submitted a request for an emergency use authorization for its COVID-19 vaccine for children aged six months to under six years, which would make it the first shot against the coronavirus available for those under 5-years-old.
- A Japanese health ministry panel approved Wednesday a plan to initially administer fourth COVID-19 vaccine shots only to the elderly and people with underlying medical conditions.

### **ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Vaccination Coverage Status** (Percent of population)




#### World: New Cases by Region

## ASEAN+3: Daily New Cases by Size of Population


(7-day average; thousand cases)
