### **Recent Developments**

#### **Global News**

- To minimize movement of Covid-positive patients, **New York City** will <u>deliver antiviral</u> <u>pills, for free, to the homes of people who test positive</u> and are at higher risk.
- Germany's finance minister said the government should prepare to loosen restrictions, with business groups needing to plan for events including trade fairs.
- After reporting record-high daily caseload over the weekend, the **Turkish** health minister said the severity of the virus has weakened, comparing the death rate to that of the flu.
- <u>Thousands of demonstrators</u> converged in Ottawa to protest against the Canadian government's vaccine mandate for truckers entering **Canada**.
- Health authorities in **Denmark** said that the <u>Omicron subvariant</u>, <u>BA.2</u>, <u>appears to be</u> more contagious but data does not show it to be more virulent so far.

#### **Regional News**

- **Singapore** has detected <u>48 local cases and 150 imported cases with the BA.2 Omicron</u> subvariant as of January 25.
- **Beijing** has reported its <u>highest number of cases in 18 months</u>, with Winter Olympics athletes or officials accounting for 13 out of the 20 cases reported on Sunday.
- The Omicron variant drove <u>hospital bed occupancy in Tokyo</u> to 48.5 <u>percent</u> on Sunday, near the 50 percent threshold for the government to request for a state of emergency.
- **Korea** plans to add hundreds of small neighbourhood hospitals and clinics next month in anticipation of higher hospital admission amid the ongoing Omicron surge.

#### **Vaccine News**


- China's Walvax Biotechnology <u>has recruited most of the 28,000 participants needed for a large clinical trial of its mRNA COVID-19 vaccine candidate</u>, the ARCoV vaccine, potentially the first mRNA vaccine from China.
- Zuellig Pharma, a **Singapore**-based company, has launched a <u>blockchain-based</u> tracking system that verify the provenance and authenticity of COVID-19 vaccines.

## ASEAN+3 and Selected Economies: Cumulative Vaccines Administered


