# **Recent Developments**

#### **Global News**

- Community transmission of the omicron variant has been confirmed in **England**.
- The <u>omicron variant has spread to about one-third of states</u> in the **US**, but the delta variant continue to account for the majority of COVID-19 infections in the country.
- Effective December 27, <u>all private employees in **New York** need to be vaccinated</u> before being allowed to return to work.
- **South Africa** is <u>preparing its hospitals for more admissions</u> as average daily cases breached 10,000, driven by the omicron variant.
- **WHO's** chief scientist reiterates that there is <u>no reason to panic over the omicron variant</u> as many cases appear to be mild or without symptoms.

### **Regional News**

- **Japan** aims to <u>shorten the current eight-month interval</u> to at least six months for fully vaccinated individuals to become <u>eligible for booster doses</u>.
- Korea will <u>limit private gatherings to six people in metropolitan areas and eight people in other areas</u>, in a bid to stem the rapid increase in cases.
- Thailand has detected its first case of the omicron variant in a foreign citizen who traveled to the country from Spain late last month.
- In **Vietnam**, under a two-week pilot scheme, <u>students from the first</u>, <u>ninth and 12th grade can return to school on December 13</u>, while kindergarteners can return a week later.

# **Vaccine News**

- **South Africa's** Biovac Institute will <u>start producing Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine</u> in early 2022 after receiving the drug substance from Europe.
- A study by University of Oxford has found <u>better immune response</u> for individuals who
  receive a <u>first dose of an Oxford-AstraZeneca or Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine followed by
  Moderna's vaccine nine weeks later.


