#### **Recent Developments**

#### **Global News**

- Cases in the **United States** more than doubled since two weeks ago, with surging hospitalization in states with low vaccination rates.
- Patients in critical care in **France** rose by 111, the highest daily increase since early-April. Cases rose to levels last seen in early-May, driven largely by the Delta variant.

#### **Regional News**

- **Singapore** has <u>relaxed restrictions today</u>, including allowing dine-in. <u>Restrictions will be eased further on August 19</u> when 80 percent of the population has been vaccinated.
- Malaysia has <u>eased restrictions for fully vaccinated individuals</u>, including allowing returning residents to serve quarantine at their own residence. Further reopening will be contingent on symptomatic hospitalization and vaccination progress.
- The US CDC warned against travel to **Thailand** after <u>cases surged to record high of</u> more than 20,000 per day.
- Cambodia is <u>expanding quarantine facilities</u> at the provinces bordering with **Thailand**, in anticipation of the influx of workers returning from **Thailand**.
- Confirmed cases in Japan more than tripled since end-July following the rapid spread
  of the Delta variant. Tokyo remains under a fourth state of emergency, amid increasing
  calls for a nationwide state of emergency.

#### **Vaccine News**

- **Korea** approved <u>Phase III trial for its first homegrown protein-based vaccine</u>, developed by **SK Bioscience**. Data from early trials showed that it induced neutralizing antibodies.
- **US**-based **Inovio Pharmaceuticals** will <u>launch a global late-stage trial of its vaccine candidate next month</u>, focusing on Latin America, Asia Pacific and African regions.


