Recent Developments

Global News

- In the United States, those who have been fully vaccinated will be allowed to gather in small groups indoors without face masks or social distancing measures. Travel should still be avoided.
- New virus variant from **Brazil**, the P1, is <u>more contagious and is able to reinfect</u> <u>recovered COVID-19 patients.</u> Confirmed cases in Brazil surged by more than 66,000 in the last 7 days, partly driven by the new variant.

Regional News

- **Philippines** reported <u>more than 2,000 new cases for the tenth consecutive day</u>, due mainly to presence of highly transmissible new variants and reopening of the economy. Sinovac vaccine has been approved, but not for use by healthcare workers.
- Beginning April, Thailand will <u>halve mandatory quarantine period to 7 days for foreign</u> <u>visitors who have been vaccinated</u> within 3 months of the travel period. Unvaccinated visitors will have to serve 10 days quarantine.
- Indonesia has <u>approved AstraZeneca vaccine</u>, after receiving more than 1 million doses of the vaccine. More than 11.7 million doses will arrive in batches until May.

Vaccine News

- World Health Organisation (WHO) advises <u>against the introduction of "vaccine</u> <u>passports" as a pre-requisite to international travel</u> due to inadequate supply and uneven distribution of vaccines globally.
- In a laboratory study, Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine was reported to be <u>able to neutralise</u> the P1 new variant of coronavirus that was first identified in Brazil. Testing for a third booster dose to induce stronger immune response is underway.


