## **Recent Developments**

### **Global News**

- In New Zealand, <u>Auckland went into a 3-day lockdown</u> following the discovery of three new local cases infected with the UK strain. This is the first lockdown in New Zealand since August. As a result, **Australia** has <u>suspended its travel bubble</u> with New Zealand for an initial period of 72 hours.
- Daily new cases in the United States have <u>dropped to below 100,000</u>, levels last observed in early November.

## **Regional News**

 Several regional economies will soon <u>launch their vaccination campaigns</u>. Tomorrow, Japan will begin inoculating health workers with the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine, the first one to be approved for domestic use. Malaysia and Korea will roll out their vaccination programs next week.

### Vaccine News

- The World Health Organization has <u>approved AstraZeneca and University of Oxford's</u> <u>COVID-19 vaccine for emergency use</u>, as produced by AstraZeneca-SKBio in Korea and the Serum Institute of India. The vaccine makes up the largest share of doses in the COVAX initiative, with rollout expected later this month.
- A new trial will test the Oxford/AstraZeneca vaccine in children aged between 6 and 17 years. This is the first trial of a coronavirus vaccine in children this young.


