Statistics

- Total confirmed cases across the ASEAN+3 region surpassed 2 million.
- The daily increase in cases in **Japan** posed another <u>record of almost 6,000 cases</u>, including record new cases in Tokyo.
- Indonesia's daily new cases reached a <u>new high of 8,854 cases</u>, and 187 new deaths.
- In **Malaysia**, close to 2,600 new cases have been confirmed, a record high.
- **China** reported <u>63 new cases, the highest increase in five months</u>. The number includes 52 local cases, almost all in Hebei province.
- Outside the region, <u>record daily tallies</u> were recorded in the **United Kingdom** (+70,786) and **South** Africa (+21,832).

News

- From next Monday, Indonesia will tighten restrictions for two weeks in parts of Java and on Bali.
 Measures include reduced opening hours for malls, limited capacity for non-essential businesses, restaurants, and places of worship, and a ban on other social and cultural activities.
- In **China**, restrictions in Shijiazhuang, the capital of Hebei province, have been tightened amid a worsening outbreak. Residents will be banned from leaving the city by train, and airlines have cancelled flights.
- In the **Philippines**, following Pfizer/BioNTech's application for vaccine approval last month, <u>AstraZeneca has now also applied for emergency use authorization</u>.
- The **European Union's** medicines agency has granted approval for Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine, following the vaccine's approval in the United States, Canada and Israel.
