












- **Worldwide** confirmed cases rose by more than half a million cases yesterday. Total confirmed cases globally is now 77.4 million, with 1.7 million deaths.
- 15,023 new cases were reported across the **ASEAN+3 region** yesterday.
- **Thailand** reported its highest daily increase of 809 new cases on Monday. There has been a total of 1,416 new cases in the last 4 days, the highest surge Thailand has seen since early-April.
- **Malaysia** reported 2,018 new cases yesterday, the third highest daily increase since the onset of the pandemic. 7 of the new cases were imported while the remainder were locally transmitted, mainly in the state of Selangor.
- New cases also continued to surge in Korea, with a 7-day average of 1,013 as of yesterday. Smaller albeit widespread outbreaks in a prison, nursing homes, hospitals, a ski resort and a golf course contributed to this increase.

News

- The new variant of the coronavirus found in **United Kingdom (UK)** is suspected to have a higher propensity to infect children, unlike previous strains. The higher transmissibility of this variant has prompted at least 21 economies, including Singapore and Hong Kong, to close their borders with the UK.
- New COVID-19 cases surged in **South Africa** driven by a novel variant of the coronavirus that appears to be more infectious than the original virus. The new variant is believed to be different from the viral strain that is dominating the rising cases in the UK.
- Governors in **Tokyo** and neighbouring prefectures, including Fukushima and Niigata, have urged the elderly and people with underlying health issues as well as those living with them to wear masks at home. **Japan** has also suspended its domestic travel promotion amid fears of a prolonged peak that risk overburdening the health care system.
- First batch of vaccine arrived in Singapore yesterday. Vaccination will begin in early-2021 with priority given to healthcare and frontline workers, as well as elderly and vulnerable patients.
- **Malaysia** has secured 6.4million doses of vaccine from AstraZeneca. The Government is in final stages of negotiations with Sinovac, CanSino Biologics and Gamaleya Research to ensure sufficient doses to cover more than 80% of the population.


