Statistics

- Worldwide confirmed cases surpassed 52 million yesterday, after more than 670,000 new cases were reported globally. Total deaths reached 1.28 million.
- In the **ASEAN+3 region**, more than 9,200 new infections were reported yesterday.
- China** saw 15 new infections yesterday, down from the previous day's figure of 17. Of the new cases, one was a local infection in Tianjin. The rest of the new cases were imported.
- New cases in **Korea** reached 143 yesterday, marking the fifth-straight day of new infections above 100. Of the new cases, 15 were imported. Total confirmed cases neared 28,000.
- Total confirmed cases in Myanmar surpassed 64,000 yesterday, after it reported around 1,200 new infections. The death toll also reached 1,480 after 19 new fatalities.
- New infections in **Malaysia** eased for the second day yesterday, when it reported 822 new infections. Total confirmed cases increased to more than 42,800, while deaths reached 302.
- Total infections in Italy topped 1 million yesterday, when it reported nearly 33,000 new cases. It also saw more than 600 new deaths, the highest single-day increase since April.
- Iran** set record-highs for both new cases and new deaths yesterday, when it saw 11,780 new infections, along with 462 new deaths. This pushed its total confirmed cases to more than 715,000, while deaths have breached 39,600.

News

- Brazil's** health regulator yesterday allowed the resumption of late-stage trials for China's Sinovac vaccine, after initially suspending these last Monday, November 9. The death of one study subject was found to be unrelated to the trials.
- The vaccine candidate of US biotech company Moderna is expected to show "a similar degree of efficacy" to the one being developed by BioNTech and Pfizer, according to top US infectious diseases expert Dr. Anthony Fauci. Early data on the BioNTech-Pfizer vaccine showed a 90 percent efficacy. Moderna is expected to announce its results soon.
- Russia** yesterday reported that its Sputnik V vaccine is 92 percent effective, according to the results of interim trials. This came after 20 confirmed cases in its first 16,000 trial participants were observed. Sputnik V trials are expected to continue for six months. On the other hand, trials of Russia's second vaccine, developed by the Vector Institute, are expected to commence on Sunday, November 15.

Due to a holiday tomorrow, the Covid Monitor will resume on Monday, November 16.
