## Statistics

- **Worldwide** confirmed cases surpassed 43 million, with close to 1.16 million confirmed deaths.
- 8,025 new cases were reported across the **ASEAN+3 region** yesterday.
- **Myanmar** confirmed 1,426 new cases, its highest increase in more than two weeks, for a total of 46,200 confirmed cases and 1,122 confirmed deaths.
- **Malaysia** reported a record increase of 1,240 cases for a total of 27,805 confirmed cases and 236 confirmed deaths.
- **Indonesia** reported 3,222 new cases, the lowest tally since mid-September.
- **India** reported 36,470 new cases, the lowest increase since mid-July. In total, more than 7.9 million cases and close to 120,000 deaths have been confirmed.

## News

- **Malaysia** has extended its Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) across Kuala Lumpur, Selangor and Putrajaya for two weeks until November 9.
- **Hong Kong** will announce a further relaxation of its social distancing measures. Beaches will likely reopen on Friday and group sizes allowed in restaurants and bars will increase.
- In the **Philippines**, Metro Manila and several other regions will remain under general community quarantine (GCQ) for another month until end-November, which allows most businesses to operate.
- The paused clinical trial of Eli Lilly & Co.'s experimental antibody treatment will not resume. The trial was paused due to a safety concern which has since been dismissed, but the trial data suggests the treatment is unlikely to help hospitalized Covid-19 patients recover.
