#### **Statistics**

- Worldwide, a <u>record increase of more than half a million cases</u> was reported on Friday. With almost 800,000 additional cases over the weekend, worldwide confirmed cases have reached almost 43 million cases.
- In the ASEAN+3 region, confirmed cases grew strongest in Malaysia and Myanmar. Malaysia confirmed a record 1,228 new cases on Saturday, and Myanmar reported a two-week high of 1,423 cases. Yesterday's increase was lower by more than 400 new cases in each country.
- China reported <u>137 and 161 new asymptomatic cases over the weekend</u>, which are not part of its number of total confirmed cases. A cluster of asymptomatic cases at a garment factory in Xinjiang's Kashgar sparked a testing drive and strict movement restrictions.
- **France** reported <u>record increases of cases over the weekend</u> and surpassed Argentina and Spain to register the <u>world's fifth-highest number of confirmed cases</u>.
- The **United States** confirmed a <u>record of more than 80,000 cases</u> each on Friday and Saturday, once again surpassing India in terms of daily incidence for the global top spot.

#### News

- <u>Several European countries continue to tighten measures</u>. **Spain** announced a state of emergency and imposed a curfew, **Italy** imposed the toughest restrictions since the spring, and **Ireland** is the <u>first to re-impose a nationwide lockdown for six weeks</u>. Notably, schools and childcare services will remain open.
- Moderna's mRNA-1273 vaccine, one of the current frontrunners among vaccine candidates against Covid-19, has completed enrollment of 30,000 U.S. participants for its Phase 3 trial, including those over the age of 65, of different ethnicities, and with high-risk chronic diseases. More than 85% of participants have already received their second vaccination. Moderna will determine whether to request Emergency Use Authorization once the two months of median safety follow-up have accrued.
- The Phase 3 trial for AstraZeneca and University of Oxford's Covid-19 vaccine can resume in the United States. It was paused because of potential safety concerns and had already resumed in other countries over the last few weeks.
- Italy's Lombardy region was one of the most severely affected regions worldwide in the early pandemic with a fatality rate of close to 12 percent as the initial surge overwhelmed its health system. The region has now created a "COVID-19 investigative commission" to better understand the impacts and drivers of its outbreak, and to analyze the sequence of events and policy choices. The aim is to learn and share lessons and provide accountability.
