Statistics

- Worldwide confirmed cases <u>surpassed 27.5 million</u>, with close to 900,000 confirmed deaths.
- With <u>3,046 new cases</u> reported yesterday, **Indonesia** has <u>surpassed 200,000 cases in total</u>. A total of 8,230 deaths have been confirmed.
- Malaysia reported 100 new cases, the first three-digit increase since early June, including 85 locally transmitted cases, all related to the cluster in Sabah and one new cluster in Kedah.
- Cases in **Myanmar** increased by 289 (*NB: number based on JHU data; other sources report 191 new cases*), its <u>highest single-day spike yet</u>, to 1,807 (*1,709*) cases in total.
- Spain recorded more than 9,000 cases a day on average over the last week, a higher number than at the height of its first wave in March/April.

News

- Hong Kong announced a <u>slow and gradual relaxation of some of its social distancing</u>
 <u>measures</u>. From Friday onwards, certain recreational facilities—including sports venues—
 can reopen, while the two-person limit on certain gatherings will be raised to four. Maskwearing will remain mandatory.
- In **Singapore**, organizers can apply to pilot meetings, incentives, conventions and exhibitions events for up to 250 participants from October onwards, from the previous cap of 50 people.
- **Korea's** Celltrion will start <u>commercial production of its experimental Covid-19 treatment</u> this month, amid ongoing clinical trials. Celltrion is planning on making a request for emergency use of the drug soon.
- The <u>Phase 3 trial for the Covid-19 vaccine</u> AZD1222 co-developed by AstraZeneca and the University of Oxford <u>has been put on hold due to a suspected serious adverse reaction in a participant</u> in the United Kingdom. The trial is paused for the standard reviewing of safety data by an independent committee.
- Nine biopharma companies pledged to continue to make the safety and well-being of vaccinated individuals the top priority in development of the first COVID-19 vaccines amid concerns that political pressure might compromise safety. The nine companies are AstraZeneca, BioNTech, GlaxoSmithKline plc, Johnson & Johnson, Merck (also known as MSD), Moderna, Inc., Novavax, Inc., Pfizer Inc., and Sanofi.
