## Statistics

- **Worldwide** confirmed cases surpassed 27 million, with more than 880,000 confirmed deaths.
- More than half a million cases have now been confirmed across the **ASEAN** economies.
- **Indonesia** reported 3,444 new cases, the fifth straight day with confirmed new cases above 3,000.
- **Myanmar** reported at least 100 cases daily over the weekend, for a total of 1,419 cases.
- 119 new cases were confirmed in **Korea**, the lowest increase since mid-August and remaining under 200 for five consecutive days.
- Total confirmed cases in **India** surpassed 4 million on Friday and it surpassed Brazil as the second-worst hit country globally over the weekend. More than 90,000 cases have been confirmed daily for the last two days, the highest increase ever reported in any country.

## News

- Travelers arriving in **Malaysia** from **Singapore** under the Periodic Commuting Arrangement (PCA) will be required to quarantine at dedicated centers instead of at home after a returning Malaysian under the scheme had tested positive. They will also have to bear the costs for the quarantine centers.
- In the **Vietnamese** city of Da Nang, all passenger transportation can resume services today after flights, buses and trains from and to the city were suspended on July 28. The move follows the easing of social distancing measures after its Covid-19 outbreak had been brought under control.
- The lockdown in **Australia's** second-wave epicenter Melbourne has been extended until September 28. The lockdown, ordered on August 2, has shut down most of the economy, limited people's movements and imposed a nightly curfew. From September 14, rules will be slightly eased. If infections rate subside by end-September, restrictions will be gradually relaxed over another two months.
- **Mexico** identified close to 123,000 excess deaths from mid-March to August 1 compared to nationwide fatalities in the 2015-18 average, suggesting that the actual coronavirus death toll could be much higher. Mexico has confirmed 67,558 Covid-19 deaths so far, the fourth highest death toll across countries after the United States, Brazil and India.


