Statistics

- The **worldwide** death toll has surpassed 900,000. Almost 300,000 new cases were reported yesterday, one of the highest increases to date, for a total of more than 27.8 million confirmed cases.
- Seven new cases were reported in **China**, all imported. China has recorded 25 consecutive days without local transmission.
- 3,307 cases were confirmed in **Indonesia**, for seven days of more than 3,000 daily new cases within the last eight days.
- 202 new cases were reported for **Myanmar**, surpassing 2,000 cases in total. 14 deaths have been confirmed so far.
- An all-time high of more than 95,000 new cases was confirmed in **India** yesterday, with 1,172 new deaths. Total confirmed infections in India stand at over 4.46 million.
- The second waves in both France and Spain continue to edge higher than their respective first waves. France reported more than 8,500 new cases yesterday and cases in Spain rose by close to 9,000 for the second day in a row.

News

- **Indonesia's** capital Jakarta will again impose large-scale social restrictions (PSBB), set to start on Monday as it continues to see a rise in cases. PSBB was originally imposed in April and May, followed by a "new normal" of limited capacity in June. Under the re-imposition, non-essential workers will have to work from home, entertainment venues and schools will have to close, and restaurants and cafes will only be available for take-out and delivery.
- **Singapore** will start distributing contact-tracing tokens nationwide from next week onwards. The so called TraceTogether tokens or the TraceTogether app will be mandatory to enter selected pilot venues.
- In **Japan's** capital Tokyo, requests for restaurants and karaoke parlors to close at 10pm will be dropped next Tuesday, and the metro area's alert level will be lowered by one notch.
- Amid rising cases in the **United Kingdom**, new restrictions on social gatherings will limit group sizes to no more than six, tightening the current rules that limit gatherings to 30 people.


