Statistics

- 4,877 new cases were reported across the **ASEAN+3 region** yesterday, the lowest increase in more than six weeks.
- 295 new cases were reported for **Japan**, the lowest increase since mid-July.
- **Singapore** reported 22 new cases, including 18 cases among dormitory residents. This is the lowest daily tally in almost six months.
- **Korea** confirmed 136 new cases, as daily cases have remained below 200 for six straight days.
- **Malaysia** reported 62 new cases, its highest increase since early June. Of these cases, 50 were linked to a cluster in Sabah state, stemming from the detention of two undocumented migrants two weeks earlier.
- In Western Europe, **Spain** has become the first country with more than half a million confirmed cases in total as it reported more than 26,500 cases between Saturday and Monday.

News

- Chinese company Sinovac Biotech Ltd announced preliminary results from a Phase 1/2 trial of its coronavirus vaccine candidate involving 421 participants above 60 years. Complete results have not been published yet, but the vaccine appears to be safe for older people, though with a slightly weaker immune response than in younger people.
- The same drugmaker, Sinovac, has begun to administer its vaccine to its staff under the country's emergency use scheme which allows for the use of vaccines for specific high risk groups and essential workers. Around 90% of its employees and their families have agreed to the injections. The vaccine is currently still undergoing Phase 3 trials.


