## Statistics

- **Worldwide** confirmed cases surpassed 19 million, with almost 715,000 confirmed deaths.
- With 3,480 new cases, the **Philippines** passed **Indonesia** as having the worst outbreak within **the ASEAN+3 region** with a total of almost 120,000 confirmed cases.
- **China** reported 37 new cases, including 26 new infections in Xinjiang region. Xinjiang recorded a daily high at end-July, but cases have since slowed down.
- **India** recorded another daily record of more than 60,000 new infections. Total confirmed cases in India have surpassed the 2 million mark and more than 40,000 deaths have been confirmed.
- Mainly due to its outbreak in the state of Victoria, **Australia** recorded 382 new infections for a total of more than 20,000 confirmed cases.

## News

- The Covid-19 pandemic has put the **Philippine** economy into recession, as the economy shrank by 16.5% in the second quarter. A surge in infections has led to another lockdown in the capital region and surroundings until mid-August, dragging down hopes for a strong recovery in the third quarter.
