Statistics

- As the pandemic continues to accelerate, **worldwide** confirmed cases surpassed 12 million, with almost 550,000 confirmed deaths. The United States still registers the highest number of daily cases, followed by Brazil and India.
- 4,789 new cases were reported across the **ASEAN+3 region** yesterday, the highest regional daily tally since mid-February.
- Indonesia** reported a daily high of 1,853 new cases, for a total of more than 68,000 cases. The death toll stands at 3,359.
- The Philippines** reported a daily record of 2,486 new cases. In total, more than 50,000 cases have been confirmed with 1,314 deaths.
- Hong Kong's** recent outbreak seems to worsen as it reported another 24 new cases, including 19 locally transmitted after almost three weeks of no local infections.
- In the **United States**, more than 3 million cases have now been confirmed, with more than 58,000 new cases reported yesterday.
- Mexico** recorded its largest daily increase with 6,995 new cases, for a total of more than 275,000 cases. Mexico has reported almost 32,800 deaths, surpassing Spain and France to become the country with the fifth deadliest outbreak.

News

- In **Korea**, as cases linked to religious gatherings have again given rise to new clusters, gatherings at churches other than regular worship services will be banned from Friday. In addition, a QR-code based entry registration log will be implemented for churches.
- A change in visa rules for foreign students in the **United States** will likely make it impossible for international students to take classes fully online in the fall semester, even as many US colleges are trying to adjust to the challenges of safely resuming classes amid the pandemic.
