

































- **Worldwide** confirmed cases have reached almost 16.7 million cases, with close to 660,000 confirmed deaths.
- More than 5,000 new cases were reported across the **ASEAN+3 region** yesterday, driven by 1,748 new cases in **Indonesia**, 1,633 new cases in the **Philippines**, and 974 new cases in **Japan**.
- **Malaysia** reported 39 new cases, including 28 locally transmitted cases, its largest daily increase since mid-June.
- **Hong Kong** reported another 106 new cases, including 98 local cases, it's seventh day in a row with more than 100 cases.
- **China** reported 101 new cases, with 98 locally transmitted, its highest tally since early March. Most cases were reported in Xinjiang.

News

- In **Vietnam**, in response to new locally transmitted cases in Da Nang, all flights, passenger buses and trains to and from the city have been suspended, including the cancellation of all remaining evacuation flights. Social distancing measures have also been re-imposed. Measures will be in place for at least 15 days.
- Moderna, an American biotech company, has published a study showing that its experimental Covid-19 vaccine induced a robust immune response and protected against infection in a study on monkeys. Moderna also announced the start of its Phase 3 trial of the vaccine, a randomized, placebo-controlled trial expected to enroll 30,000 participants in the United States.
