






- **Worldwide** confirmed cases surpassed 7.5 million, with more than 421,000 confirmed deaths.
- In **Lao PDR**, no active cases remain as the last patient has been discharged from the hospital. Lao PDR had a total of 19 confirmed cases and no recorded deaths. No new cases have been recorded since mid-April.
- **Thailand** did not report any new cases yesterday, the first time in almost three weeks. It has gone more than two weeks without local transmission.
- **Korea** confirmed 56 new cases yesterday, pushing the total number of cases to more than 12,000. Daily new cases have remained in the double-digits since early May when new cases had slowed to single-digits.
- In the **United States**, more than 2 million cases have now been confirmed. **Brazil** has confirmed more than 800,000 cases; **Russia** more than 500,000. **India** is now the world's fourth most affected country with almost 300,000 confirmed cases.

News

- In **China**, the first locally transmitted case in Beijing since mid-April has been reported. The patient's family members were isolated and his residential compound closed. It remains unclear how the man became infected as he said he had not left Beijing in the last two weeks and had not been in touch with anyone from outside the city.
- In **Japan**, Tokyo has lifted its virus alert and is set to move into the next and final phase of its reopening plan.
- **Vietnam** is preparing to resume international flights to safe destinations which could include China, Korea, Japan and Lao PDR, with the first flights expected in early July.
