Statistics

- More than 160,000 cases have been confirmed across the **ASEAN+3 region**.
- **Indonesia** confirmed 484 new cases, its highest daily increase yet.
- **Malaysia** recorded 30 new cases yesterday, the lowest number in almost 8 weeks.
- Outside of the region, cases in **Russia, India, and Brazil** continue to grow rapidly.
- In the **United States**, deaths from COVID-10 have surpassed 70,000 among more than 1.2 million confirmed cases.

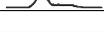
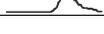
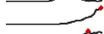
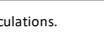
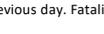
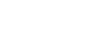
News

- In **China**, several tourist attractions have reopened after three months, under strict social distancing and health measures, and with limited visitor traffic. In Beijing, the Palace Museum, known as the Forbidden City, and several other museums opened on May 1. Shanghai Disneyland will reopen on May 11.
- **Hong Kong** announced a further relaxation of its social distancing measures. From Friday, as long as certain precautionary measures are in place, most public entertainment venues can reopen and people will be allowed to go out in groups of up to eight. The government also announced plans for students to return to school, starting May 27.

Due to a public holiday, the Covid Monitor will resume on Friday, May 8.
