Statistics

- <u>10,946 new cases</u> were reported across the **ASEAN+3 region** yesterday, as daily new cases have remained above 10,000 for the last 7 days.
- Malaysia recorded a <u>record increase of 2,188 new cases</u>.
- Hong Kong reported <u>80 new cases</u>, including <u>69 cases</u> of local transmission. The cluster around dance clubs has grown to <u>187 cases</u>.
- Myanmar confirmed 1,731 new cases, its highest increase in more than six weeks.
- **Singapore** has reported only imported cases and <u>no local transmission in two weeks</u>, as the last cluster of dormitory cases was closed. The city is free of active clusters for the first time since the pandemic started.
- As cases in the **United States** continue to rise, it reported <u>2,248 new deaths yesterday, the</u> deadliest day since June.

News

- Hong Kong will close bars, nightclubs and saunas from Thursday onwards, and encourage
 businesses to work from home. This will be the third time this year that entertainment
 venues will be closed.
- In Japan, Tokyo plans to request bars and restaurants to close at 10pm for 20 days, starting Saturday. In addition, residents will be asked to avoid non-essential trips outdoors.
- **Korean** pharmaceutical group Celltrion has administered its Covid-19 <u>antibody treatment</u> regdanvimab to all 327 patients enrolled in its Phase 2 trial, and <u>will apply for conditional approval likely before the end of the year</u> after confirming its interim results.
- Russia announced <u>further preliminary results for Sputnik V</u>, the "world's first registered Covid-19 vaccine". The second interim analysis shows an <u>efficacy of 91.4% 28 days after the first dose and above 95% efficacy 42 days after the second dose</u>. The findings are based on 39 Covid-19 cases among nearly 19,000 participants, with no serious adverse events.
- Cases in several countries in Europe seem to have peaked. France will begin to ease its
 lockdown in three stages. From Saturday, some nonessential businesses will be allowed to
 reopen, and travel restrictions will be slightly eased. Further restrictions might be eased mid December. Restaurants will have to remain closed until at least January 20, 2021.


