Recent Developments

Global News

- The <u>BA.2.12.1 Omicron subvariant is becoming the dominant strain</u> in the **US**, accounting for 47.6 percent of total new cases in May 8 14. The current mainstream subvariant, BA.2, accounted for 50.9 percent of new cases in the same period.
- South <u>Australia</u> has <u>lifted the state of emergency after 793 days</u>, with mask mandates in schools to be lifted by the end of the week.

Regional News

- Travellers from **Singapore** to **China** will <u>no longer need to do a PCR test 7 days before</u> <u>departure</u>, but will still be required to self-isolate for seven days before departure.
- Average daily cases in Korea has <u>fallen to its lowest level since Feb 4, 2022 as the</u> spread of the Omicron variant recedes.
- **Thailand** <u>may consider removing the requirement for Thailand Pass for foreigners</u>. The government said it will need to monitor imported cases more closely before deciding.
- **Singapore** has <u>closed all its relief schemes under The Courage Fund</u>, which provides income support to COVID-19 patients, following the easing of containment measures.

Vaccine News

- Germany's vaccine advisory panel said <u>one COVID-19 shot was enough for healthy 5</u> to <u>11 year-olds</u> because most of them had already undergone an infection, be it known or undetected.
- Pfizer has said that the <u>third dose of COVID-19 vaccine is 80 percent effective against</u> <u>the Omicron variant for children under the age of 5</u>.
- The **US** FDA panel will <u>meet on June 15 to make a recommendation on Pfizer-BioNTech</u> and Moderna's COVID-19 vaccines for infants and toddlers.


